Monetary Developments ^(*)

Money supply M0 increased from AED 48.0 billion at the end of February 2011 to AED 49.6 billion at the end of March of the same year (3.3%), while M1 increased from AED 242.7 billion to AED 251.6 billion (3.7%), M2 from AED 818.3 billion to AED 834.7 billion (2.0%) and M3 from AED 1,017.7 billion to AED 1,048.9 billion (3.1%). During the first quarter of 2011, M0 increased by 3.8%, M1 by 8.0%, M2 by 6.1% and M3 by 6.5%.

The Money Multiplier

The money multiplier indicates by how much the money supply (M2) will grow following an increase of 1 billion Dirhams in the monetary base (currency in circulation + banks' reserves at the Central Bank + certificates of deposits).

This multiplier decreased from 4.1 at the end of December 2010 to 3.8 at the end of March 2011, which was due mainly to an increase by AED 17.3 billion in the Central Bank's Certificates of Deposits purchased by banks.
